“And our speakers will not disappoint. We have a stellar line-up of industry, technology, and leadership experts who will inspire, educate and engage all attendees”.

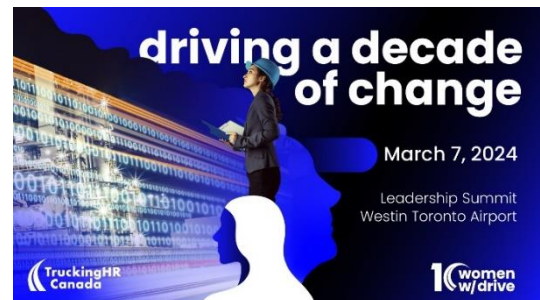
