## Largest number of Top Fleet Employers in program's history announced for 2025

Top Fleet Employers is a national initiative that recognizes fleets with HR policies and practices that meet the highest standards within the sector. It is not a competition, but a rigorous review process where applicants are evaluated on multiple criteria: skills development, workplace culture, employee engagement, recruitment practices, compensation, sustainability, community engagement, and innovative HR policies. Employees also provide feedback about their workplaces.

This year's TFE class represents regions across Canada and fleets of all sizes. Fleets that are being recognized for five, 10, or more years earn Top Fleet Employer of Distinction status. This year, there are 25 10+ year Top Fleet Employers of Distinction and 39 five+ Top Fleet Employers of Distinction.

The 2025 Top Fleet Employers will be recognized and celebrated at the 12<sup>th</sup> annual Awards Gala at the Palais Royale in Toronto on Wednesday October 15, 2025.
